# MRI LOBO

## YOU NEED

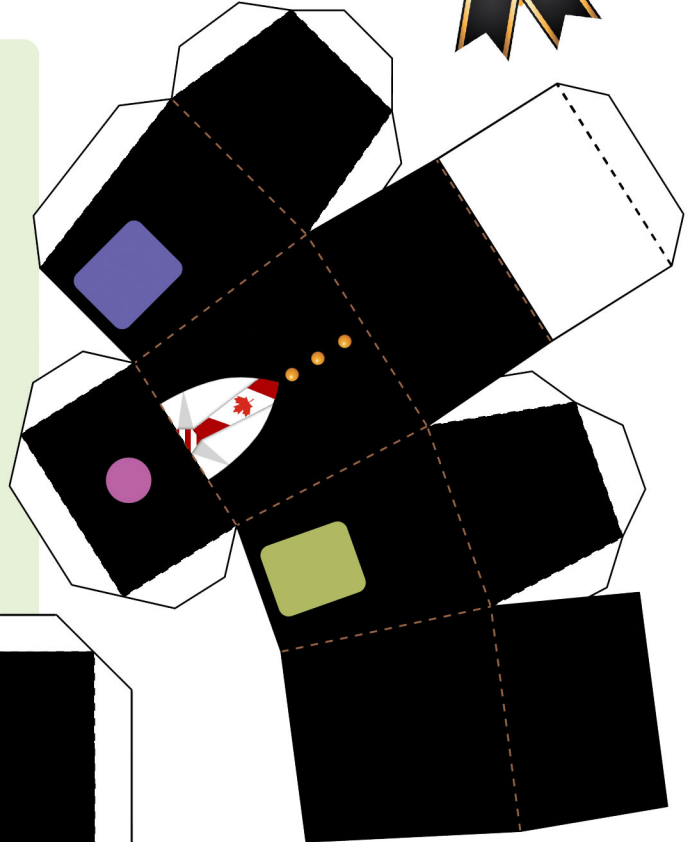
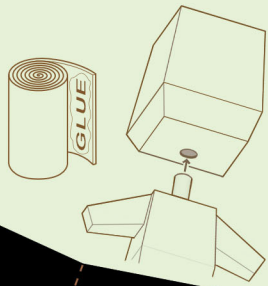
1. This page printed on cardstock, photo paper, or whatever thick, white paper you've got.
2. An X-Acto knife.
3. Glue.

## MIGHT HELP

1. A ruler.
2. A tool to score fold lines, such as a dull butter knife, paperclip, or fingernail (ask owner's permission first).
3. Small scraps of cardstock to help apply glue to those otherwise hard to reach tabs.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Solid line means cut. Dashed line means fold. Tabs get glue.
2. For best results, score all fold lines before cutting out parts.
3. Cut out, assemble, and glue one piece at a time. That way the glue will dry on one part as you work on the next.
4. The head can be glued onto the torso using the neck dots as guides, but if you'd like your figure to turn his head (like the real Mr. Lobo!), do this: Surgically remove the dot that's on the bottom of the head. Roll up and glue solid a strip of 1cm wide cardstock so that it will fit snugly in the neck hole you've cut. Glue the roll onto the torso's dot. When that's dry, insert the neck post into the head.
